

**STATEMENT****Legal requirements**

The Swiss Construction Products Act (ConProdA 2014) of 21 March 2014 and the Swiss Construction Products Ordinance (ConPO 2014) of 27 August 2014 regulate the conditions for placing and making construction products available on the market. These decrees comply with EU Regulation No 305/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 March 2011 laying down harmonised conditions for the marketing of construction products. According to these decrees, declarations of performance must be drawn up for construction products that fall under a designated “Harmonised European Standard” or for which a “European Technical Assessment” applies.

**SERTO AG Statement**

SERTO standard products such as unions, couplings, valves, tubes or hoses are neither covered by a designated “Harmonised European Standard” nor do “European Technical Assessments” exist for them. Consequently, no declarations of performance within the meaning of the Construction Products Ordinance can be issued for the SERTO products mentioned. For the same reasons, there are no CE markings for these products.

**Additional information**

Safe, trouble-free operation requires that the entire system design be considered when selecting a product. The system designer and the user are responsible for the proper functioning of the products, their material compatibility, associated performance data and limits for use as well as for handling, operation and effect in accordance with the regulations.
